Serving Team Groups

Requirements to start a Serving Team Group are:

A Serving Team Group is when two or more people serving within an existing Cypress Meadows ministry incorporate a spiritual growth group within their serving team.

Serving Team Groups are a natural way to grow deeper spiritually with a community that you are already acquainted with.



As with all Next Step Partnerships the following elements will be included when meeting together:

- ▽ Prayer
- ▽ Time of devotion, scripture reading or study
- ▽ Accountability among members for taking next steps in their spiritual journeys
- ▽ Community with one another

A serving team group may likely choose to meet before or after the time they regularly serve together. Your Ministry Team Leader may already know of an existing group or be able to direct you to others on the team that are interested in starting one.

If you know someone that shares a desire to go deeper spiritually within the ministry you serve ask them if they'd like to form a Serving Team Group together.

Another option is to ask the Next Step Coordinator whether they know of someone in your ministry interested in starting one.

- ▽ The Leader/Facilitator must be a Christ Follower, regular attendee and Member of Cypress Meadows
- ▽ The Leader/Facilitator must be trained for group leadership at Cypress Meadows
- ▽ Any chosen materials should align with the direction of the Elders, Cypress Meadow's Statement of Faith and the church's Core Values
- ▽ As with all Next Step Partnerships, we request that a *Partnership Covenant* is completed and returned to the church's office.
